1. This tournament is certified by USBC. All participants must be USBC members.
2. No refunds of entry fees will be made after the reserved closing deadline.
3. All events will have two divisions (scratch and handicap). Both events are optional and bowlers can enter one, both, or none.
4. Prize ratios will be 1 in 8 in team, singles, and doubles, with All Events scratch and handicap being 1 in 20.
5. Rules and Regulations of USBC will govern this tournament. Rule 18–Bowling Ball–altering is Prohibited.
6. Handicap shall be 80% of 220, per team unit (880 Team, 440 Doubles, and 220 Singles). Each bowler will use their 2016-2017 highest average of at least 21 games. If bowlers do not have a fall 2016-2017 average, an established average in a certified summer league which started after March 15, 2017 shall be accepted. If summer league average is used, please send final standing sheet of at least 21 games or more with the entry number. USBC Youth will NOT be accepted. The Ten Pin Rule does apply as of 4/5/2018. If an individual's average is 10 pins or more over with a minimum of 21 games, they must report and use it. All others will bowl scratch. A certified sport average may be used if there is no other certified average. It will be adjusted per the USBC average adjustment scale. Only 1 professional bowler per team or doubles, and they will bowl scratch and be assigned a 230 average.
7. Rule 319 Items (a) (b) (c) (d) & (e) will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply shall cause forfeiture of all entry fees, scores, and prize money if his/her average is higher than the one submitted on the entry form. It is each bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, their team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than the actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winning shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average.
8. Bowlers may bowl twice in Singles, as many times as they want in doubles (they must change partners), and can bowl in as many team events as they can, as long as at least 2 members are changed. A bowler's first appearance in each event shall count towards their "All Events score total". When you enter your first doubles, you must enter singles.
9. In case of a substitution, an All Events entry can be transferred if the transfer is made before either of the bowlers has participated in any events of the tournament.
10. No change in team or doubles lineups will be permitted, even though substitutions are involved. Substitutions just replace the original bowler. Any substitutions, or average changes, should be reported to the tournament director at least 1 hour prior to the scheduled time to bowl.
11. No corrections in scores or handicaps, etc., will be made except within 24 hours after the score is shot, except for obvious errors. The automatic scoring is the official score.
12. Any bowler who arrives after a game has started will be permitted to bowl, but they must start to bowl in the frame then being bowled and no score will be given for the frames missed.
13. A bowler who has qualified for a prize for a score of \$300.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 month period must report in writing his actual score, position, and amount won to the tournament management at the time of entry for possible recalculation. Failure to comply with this provision shall be cause to forfeit tournament entry fees and prize winnings. It is the bowlers responsibility to report his/her scores in any tournament where the prize fund payment has not been made but in which he/she has qualified for \$300.00 or more.
14. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the management of this tournament shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination.
15. The tournament management reserves the right to reject any entry and cancel this event with the return of entry fees.
16. Early reservation may be made by calling 918-542-5798. However, reserved closing date is midnight on April 5, 2018.
17. All protests must be made in writing prior to the time the prize money is paid. In the event of a mechanical failure, it is hereby agreed that the bowlers affected shall be moved to the next available pair of lanes. Bowlers will be allowed ten (10) minutes of practice in team and singles events. No practice is allowed for doubles event. Singles and doubles will be bowled on the same lanes.
18. All team captains shall report in at least 30 minutes prior to the time the event is scheduled to be bowled.
19. A tournament official will rule on all alleged fouls after consulting with the bowlers in the area.
